Details

ArtScope is an arts and employment training program for young people ages 13-18. Teens must complete and submit an application for consideration; not all applicants will receive interviews.

ArtScope runs for 20 hours a week for 6 weeks in the summer. The hours for each group have not yet been determined. For 16 hours of the week, you will learn alongside a Mentor Artist about the discipline in which you were hired (Writing or Mosaic). The remaining four hours will be spent working under the supervision of a guidance counselor who will provide instruction on completing job applications, locating employment, creating a resume, interviewing for jobs, goal setting and more. Upon successful program completion, Apprentices will receive a \$200 stipend.

- ArtScope runs Monday, June 17 Friday, July 26, 2013 (6 weeks)
- There is no work on Thursday, July 4 and Friday, July 5, 2013
