

Kingfield Pleasant Community Garden Gardener Agreement 2013

In order to have a plot in the garden, you must agree and abide by the rules of the garden. Any outside people that you bring in to the garden are expected to follow these rules and the plot holder is responsible for communicating the rules to their guests.

1. I will plant my plot by **the end of the first week of June**. If I do not, my plot will be assigned to another gardener.
2. I will only use organic material in my plot. I will not use chemical herbicides or pesticides or fertilizers.
3. I will keep my plot weeded, neat, and maintain the pathways around my plot.
4. If at any point I become unable to maintain my plot, I will work with the Garden Coordinator and other gardeners to make sure it does not become overgrown.
5. I will follow the rules for composting as agreed upon and communicated to me at the April meeting and outlined in the Kingfield's Pleasant Community Garden Rules 2013.
6. I will not take food or plants from other gardeners' plots.
7. I will not put plants or any structure that will infringe on the ability of people in plots near me or who I share my plot with to grow their food.
8. I will use the MN Green donated plants only in the Community Garden. I will not take them home for my personal use.
9. I will contribute a minimum of 1 hour of work per month to the Common Garden and participate in any pre/post season cleanup. I understand that an arrangement has been made between the Community Garden and the CFPA for work in trade for our water bill and that I must participate.
10. I will keep my plot watered, and I will be mindful of my water usage and the watering information communicated to me at the April meeting. I will carefully move the hose along the pathways. I will make sure the faucet is completely off when I am done watering. I will not water overnight.
11. I will report any water leaks to the Garden Coordinator, Suzie, at 612-770-3612.
12. I will remove all dead plants and temporary structures by the **October 31** fall cleanup deadline or will forfeit my \$10 plot reimbursement fee.
