## **Eagle Scout Project Funding (Sean)**

Presenter: Sean McAneney

- Project plan: Parklet for the neighborhood at an undetermined location
- Proposed timeline:
  - o Encroachment permit to be obtained by end of June
  - o Building to commence in July
- Budget Total \$1920
  - o Lumber \$1370
  - o Plants \$250
  - o Furniture (4 chairs/2 tables) \$225
  - o Permit (May-October) \$75
  - Tools/Labor (Volunteers) \$0
- Considerations

- o Pre-treat wood to make it weather proof
- o Pick-up truck (or something similar) needed for transportation
- o Long-term maintenance
- o Storage
- o Location
- o Business partnership
- o Ownership
- o Owner's manual
