



Update on 1st Ave S Traffic Changes

Construction Activities along 39th Street

- Sanitary sewer pipe installation continues at 39th Street and 2nd Ave S through early October 2018.
- To complete this work, bypass pipes are needed that stretch across the 39th Street and 1st Ave S intersection, which requires the intersection to be closed.
- The bypass pipes require **using a pump that operates 24 hours a day** and will start operating approximately on Monday, August 13.
 - o Residents may hear some noise from the pump, but a low-noise pump is being used to minimize the noise.
 - o The pump will also be monitored 24 hours a day by an onsite uniformed crew member in a marked vehicle.

Traffic Changes and Parking on 1st Ave S

Due to the 39th Street and 1st Ave S intersection closure, the following traffic and parking changes have been made on 1st Ave S (see map on back). These traffic changes will be in place through early October 2018.

• Between 38th Street and 39th Street:

- Access to/from residences is only available from 38th Street
- 1st Ave S is temporarily a two-way road
- o The bike lane is temporarily closed to allow for two-way traffic
- Parking is only allowed on the west side of 1st Ave S; vehicles need to park facing south
- Parking will be restricted for about 100 ft. at the 39th Street/1st Ave S intersection to allow for a vehicle turnaround area

Between 39th Street and 40th Street:

- Access to/from residences is only available from 40th Street
- 1st Ave S is temporarily a two-way road
- The bike lane is temporarily closed to allow for two-way traffic
- Parking is only allowed on the east side of 1st Ave S; vehicles need to park facing north
- Parking will be restricted for about 100 ft. at the 39th Street/1st Ave S intersection to allow for a vehicle turnaround area

Construction activities are subject to change due to weather, schedule and unforeseen impacts.

35W@94: Downtown to Crosstown is a reconstruction project on I-35W between 43rd Street and downtown Minneapolis. The work includes reconstructing pavement, bridges and ramps on I-35W, adding new MnPASS lanes on northbound and southbound I-35W, constructing new access ramps to the Lake Street Business District and building a new transit station on the interstate. Once complete, motorists and residents will have better accessibility, safety and mobility in the area.

Work is expected to be completed in fall 2021.
