

## Kingfield Neighbor Association (KFNA) Annual Meeting Addendum (6/23/2021)

The 2021 KFNA Board of Directors Election kicked off during the Neighborhood Association Annual Meeting on Wednesday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, lasted a week and concluded on Wednesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> at midnight.

During this election, we voted on two other items. The first item was changing the KFNA Bylaws. The Kingfield Neighborhood Association has redrafted their organizational bylaws to comply with State Laws and new City of Minneapolis funding guidelines for neighborhood associations. Do you agree with the redrafting? 101 people voted on this item and 98.02% voted yes to agree with the redrafting of the Bylaws. The second item was a Plan Modification of NRP fund. The Kingfield Neighborhood Association (KFNA) Board of Directors is requesting that Members of the Association vote to approve a KFNA NRP Plan Modification to move \$75,100 to support future Affordable Housing projects and \$79,500 to support the administrative and organizing work of our organization for the coming year. These two funding moves are bundled together into one Kingfield NRP Plan Modification vote totaling \$154,600. Do you approve this plan modification? 103 people voted on this item. 91.26% of the voters were in favor of approving the plan modification.
